CANVASS OF ELECTION

MOTION: Councilmember Davis moved to adjourn as the City Council and convene as the Board of Canvassers. Councilmember Petro seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Kimberly Read, City Recorder, presented the 2019 Municipal General Election Results provided by Davis County Elections Office and reviewed them with the Council pointing out the following:

- 169 ballots were not counted due to various identified reasons and explained them. She emphasized those voters, with the exception of deceased voters, were contacted and had the opportunity to provide a signed affidavit by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 18, 2019.
- Ballots received By Mail with which there were exceptions, voters were sent affidavits no later than Wednesday, November 6, 2019.
- Layton City experienced a 35.88% voter turnout.
