AGENDA:

CANVASS OF MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

MOTION: Councilmember Fitzpatrick moved to adjourn as the City Council and reconvene as the Board of Canvassers. Councilmember Bloxham seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **Councilmembers Morris and Thomas were not present for the vote.**

Kimberly Read, City Recorder, presented the 2021 Municipal General Election Results provided by Davis County Elections Office and reviewed them with the Council pointing out the following:

- 157 ballots were not counted due to various reasons and she provided an explanation for each of those reasons. She emphasized those voters, with the exception of the empty envelope and those received untimely, would have been notified and had the opportunity to provide a signed affidavit by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 15, 2021, to have their votes counted.
- Layton City experienced a 29.43% turnout, down from 35.88% in 2019. The Primary Election had a 23.97% turnout.
