

**MINUTES OF LAYTON CITY  
COUNCIL SPECIAL WORK MEETING**

**CANVASS OF ELECTION**

**MOTION:** Councilmember Smith Edmondson moved to adjourn as the City Council and reconvene as the Board of Canvassers at 4:03 p.m. Councilmember Morris seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Kimberly Read, City Recorder, presented the results from the 2023 Municipal Primary Election provided by the Davis County Clerk's Office, and reviewed them with the Board pointing out the following:

- Layton City experienced a 21.34% voter turnout for the Primary Election.
- Total votes cast for each candidate.
- 152 ballots were not counted due to various reasons and reviewed those with the Board:
  - 1 – deceased
  - 3 – no signature
  - 37 – signature did not match
  - 1 – empty envelope
  - 110 – not mailed/received timely

She pointed out the Special Election took place Tuesday, September 5, 2023, following Labor Day, Monday, September 4, 2023, and a special exception was granted that any ballots reflecting a postmark of September 5, or earlier, would count. Generally, the postmark would need to reflect the day before the election. She indicated those ballots which didn't count for signature reasons were given the opportunity to come in and clear up the signature issue up until the day before the Election Canvass. She asked if there were any questions and there were none.

She announced the following candidates would advance to the General Election and the following names would appear on the ballot:
