

**MINUTES OF LAYTON CITY
COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING**

The meeting was held in the Council Conference Room of the Layton City Center.

Mayor Petro opened the meeting.

AGENDA:

CANVASS OF MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

MOTION: Councilmember Smith Edmondson moved to adjourn as the City Council and reconvene as the Board of Canvassers. Councilmember Bloxham seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **Councilmember Roberts was not present for the vote.**

Kimberly Read, City Recorder, presented the 2023 Municipal General Election Results provided by Davis County Elections Office and reviewed them with the Council pointing out the following:

- Layton City experienced a 23.73% turnout, an increase from 21.34% for the Primary Election. The 2021 General Election experienced a 29.43% turnout.
- 129 ballots were not counted due to various reasons and provided an explanation for each of those reasons. She emphasized those voters, with the exception of one empty envelope and those received untimely, would have been notified and had the opportunity to provide a signed affidavit by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 4, 2023, to have their votes counted.

She announced the following had been elected to three City Council seats during the 2023 Municipal General Election:

CITY COUNCIL – Three (3) four-year seats

Clint Morris	6,220	Elected
Zach Bloxham	5,897	Elected
Dave Thomas	5,068	Elected

She announced the following had been eliminated during the 2023 Municipal General Election:

Mike Kolendrianos	3,482	Eliminated
Teresa Stokes	2,730	Eliminated
Elicia Clegg	2,206	Eliminated

A total of 9,668 ballots were received from 40,740 Registered Voters.

MOTION: Board Member Smith Edmondson moved to accept the 2023 General Election Results as presented. Board Member Thomas seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **Councilmember Roberts was not present for the vote.**
